Summer is Joon us and the pool is open. Tuesday, May 29th, the suits went on, the pool opened, and session 1 of swim lessons began. The Village Pool: The pool opened for both lessons and free swim on Tuesday, May 29<sup>th</sup>. Please make sure that you bring in a swimsuit, towel, water shoes, and sunscreen, <u>all clearly labeled</u>, for your child if you have not already. All swimsuits and towels need to be taken home every Friday, washed, and brought back to The Village the following Monday. If your child does not have swim shoes they will not be allowed in the pool (no exceptions). We require swim shoes at The Village pool because it cuts down on the likelihood that the children will slip inside or outside of the pool and get hurt. The bottom of the pool is also textured to help prevent slipping which tends to be too abrasive on bare feet everyday. Socks and sandals will not be allowed in the pool. There will be pool toys provided for the children to play with in the water, so no floatation devices or toys should be brought from home, except for goggles. If you have any questions, please let us know.

<u>Vacation Request:</u> Please keep in mind that "vacation request forms" must be filled out in order to utilize any vacation credit. Vacation credit can be used for any missed days, including sick days.

As summer progresses, often schedules and our daily lives can get busy and change. If you will be leaving The Village, we do require a written 2 week notice. You can stop by and pick up a disenrollment form to submit your request in writing. Also, don't forget to turn in your entry cards on your child's last day. Thanks!
